NCC

World Cancer Day

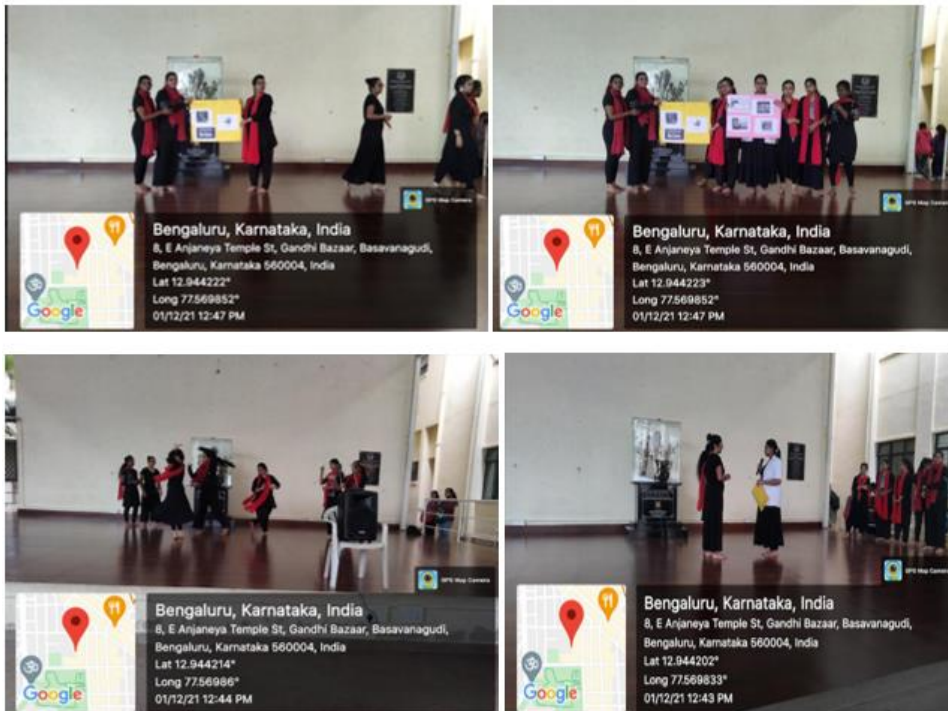
