Mechanism of Feedback:


- A Google form was created with questions pertaining to the different aspects to be assessed

Aspects of the Questionnaire:


The feedback questionnaire comprised of 21 questions. A total of 631 students (from all the streams) responded to the questionnaire. The overall responses were positive.

The following summary points extracted from the SSS 2021-22.


Criterion II – Teaching–Learning and Evaluation
Student Satisfaction Survey on Teaching Learning Process




Around 74% students are satisfied about the syllabus covered in the class.




Around 92% of Students responded that teachers are well prepared for the class and they are satisfied about their teaching.




Majority of the students are stated that teachers are able to communicate with the students effectively.




Around 68 % of the respondents have stated that the teachers approach to teaching is very good & excellent.




78% of the students have responded that the Internal Evaluation process is fair by the teacher.




Around 70% of respondents stated that performance in assignments discussed with them always and suggestions will be given for further improvisation.



Majority of students responded that institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange and field visit opportunities are provided for the students from various departments.




70 % of the respondents have highly benefitted from the mentoring process and volunteering programme of institution.




72% of respondents agreed that the institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.




72% of students stated that teachers informs them about course outcomes and programme outcomes which helps them in future.




Around 70 % of the respondents are satisfied with the mentoring process.




83% of respondents satisfied with the teaching methods of teachers.




Around 70% of respondents stated that teachers try to identify the strengths of students and based on that they will encourage to reach the right level of challenges.




Around 60% of respondents stated that teachers are able to identify the weakness of students and help them to overcome them.




70% of the respondents agreed that to improve quality of teaching learning process the institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring and reviewing process.




Around 70% of the respondents satisfied with student centric methods of teaching and learning such as experimental learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies so on.




76% of respondents stated that teachers encourage them to participate in extracurricular activities which enhances their skills in various field.
