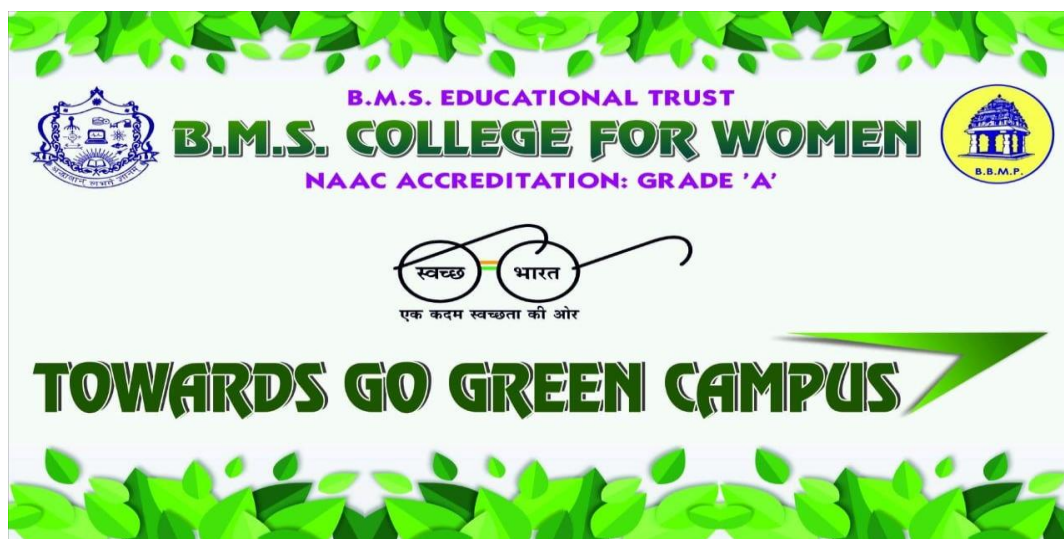

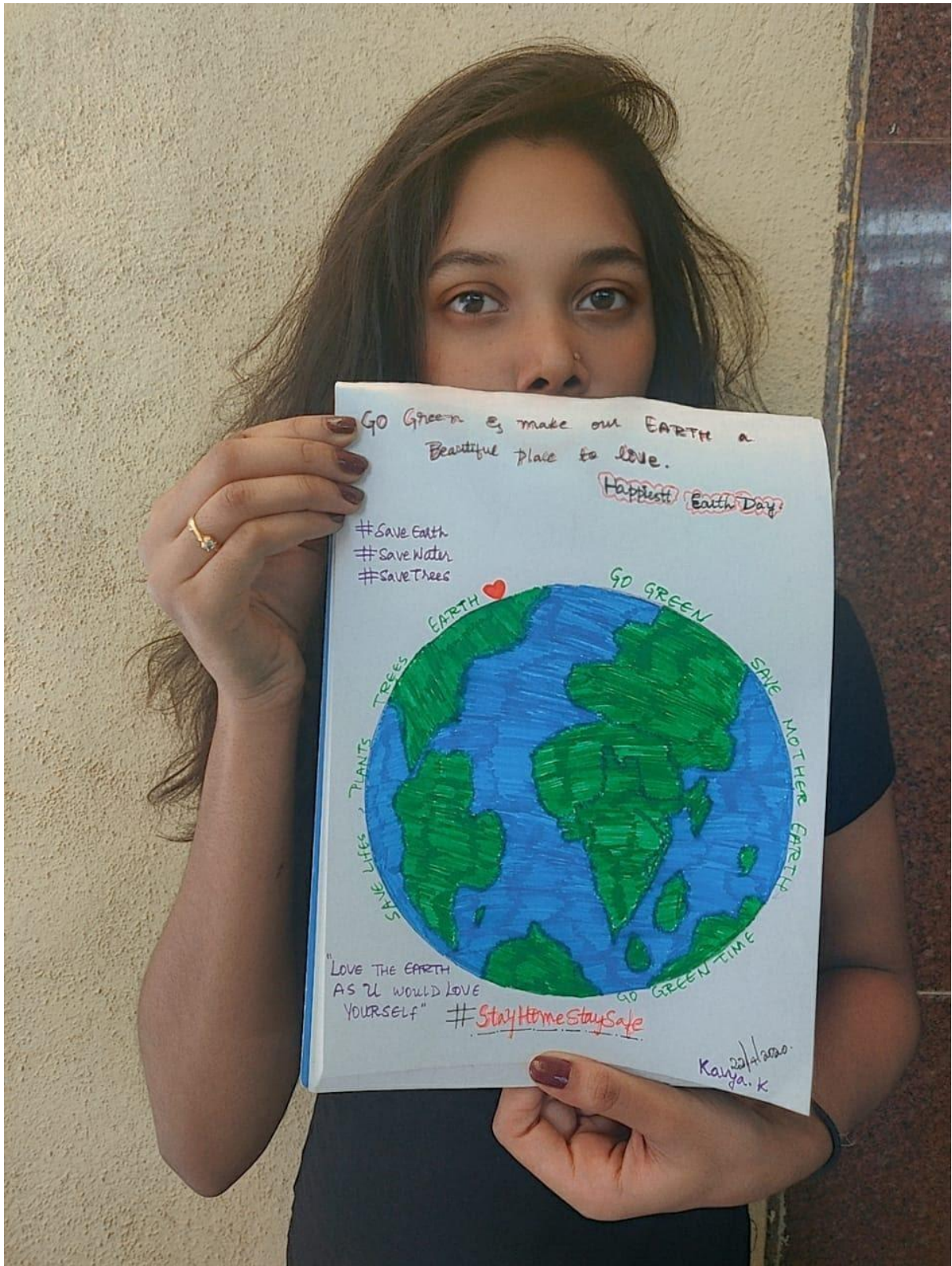

About the Programme

Here is an opportunity to initiate kitchen garden at home.

Commencement of event "GO GREEN BY GROWING GREEN DURING LOCKDOWN DUE TO COVID-19" will be from **10.05.2020**.

1. Each student must grow at least **FIVE DIFFERENT PLANTS**. Any number of students from each college may register through the link <http://shorturl.at/hpzEP>
2. Seeds of spices and condiments used in different ailments may be sown in pots/ any container or garden area. Seeds germinated by any methods can also be sown.
3. Common spices to be used are Sasuve-Mustard, Jeerige-Jeera, Soamp-Fennel, Menthye—Methi, Dhaniya-Coriander, Sabsige seeds, chillies, etc.,
4. Any other seeds like, groundnut, green gram, Bengal gram, etc., can also be sown.
5. Pudina cuttings, onion, garlic, tomatoes etc., can also be grown.
6. The action photos of the plants at an interval of 5 days at different stages by the student in GPS mode to be sent to the e-mail ID bmsewiqac.greencampus@gmail.com without fail. An example photo is shown in brochure for reference.
7. Use of compost manure is preferred.
8. A brief write up of the process of plantation and importance of the plants along with photos/videos at different stages of all the plants must be sent on or before 1st June 2020.
9. Best participants will be announced on World Environment Day (5th June 2020).

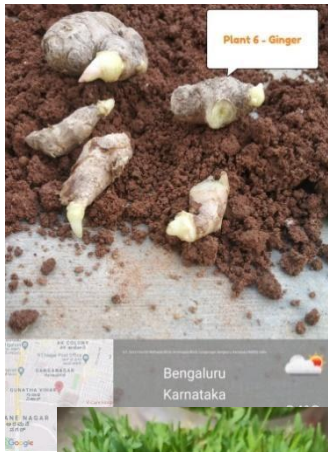

2. Each Student must create their Own Trash to Art form of Treasure (Crafting/Sculpting) & Click the photo with GPS mode (Only Colored Images are accepted) and send it to this e-mail ID bmscwogreencampus@gmail.com without fail. (Note: Photo of trash collected to be sent at the beginning with a sketch of what they are going to do (Example:- Sculpture, Table, Bag, Stand) Along with student photo .
3. Multiple exposures, composite images, sandwich shots and photographs which consist in any way of more than one separate image or which have been manipulated, are not eligible.
4. Captured Images submitted must be entirely original and taken by the participant. Images should be digital (for example: JPEG format) and capable of being transferred to a computer.
5. The file size must not exceed 4 MB, with a minimum resolution of 800 pixels.
6. Each Registered Participant must send at least 3 Photos of their Treasure created out of Trash. Trash of Materials Participants may use may be any recyclable and reusable materials e.g plastics / glass / paper / fabrics / wood tweed / twin etc
7. The Treasure of Art work created by the participant must be useful and Originally created by participant.
8. A Brief Writeup of the process of creating Trash to Treasure should be sent along with the Photo/Video within the date: 12th August,2020.

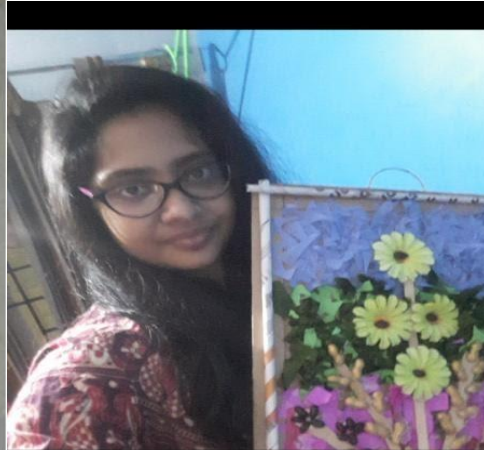

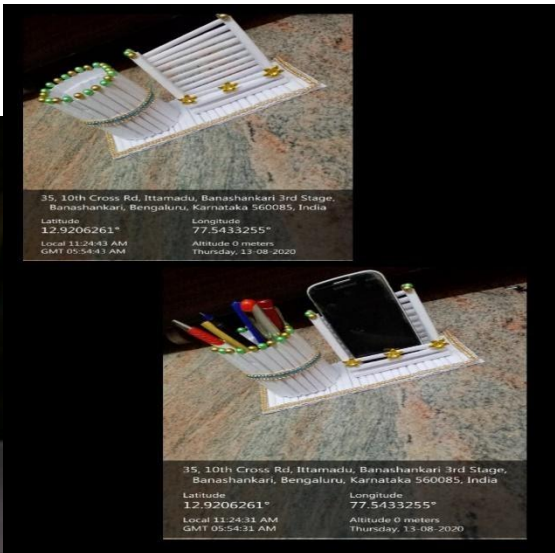
