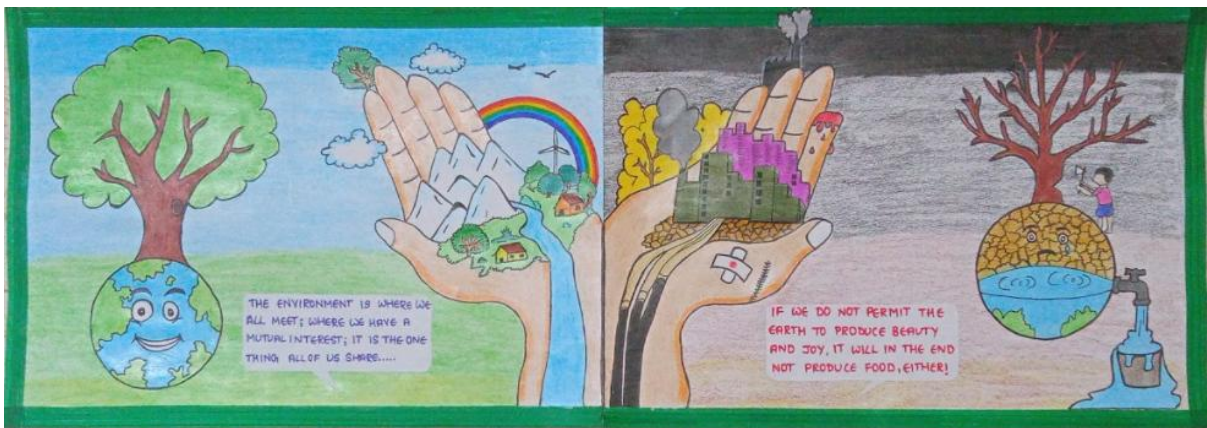
It shows that climatic change threats should be treated on an urgent basis as it can cause a wildfire on the earth. Either we need to stop or the condition will stop us.

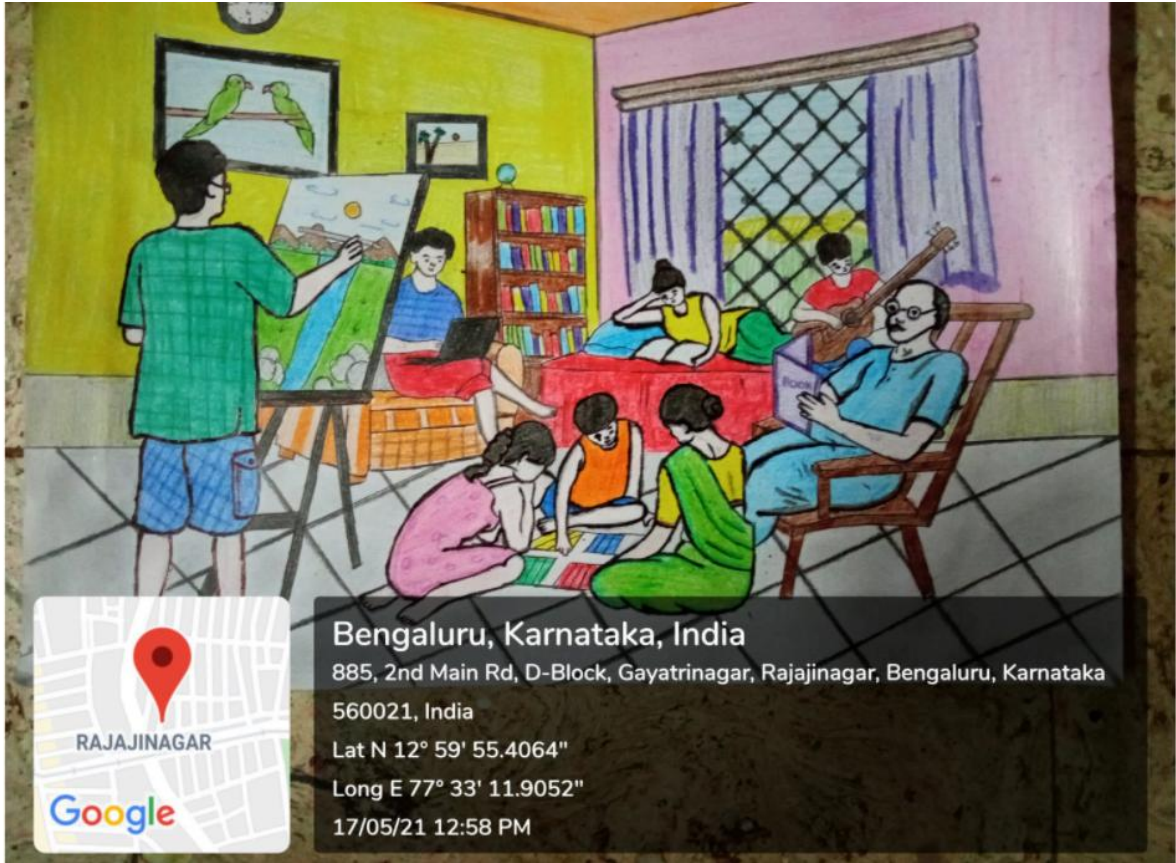

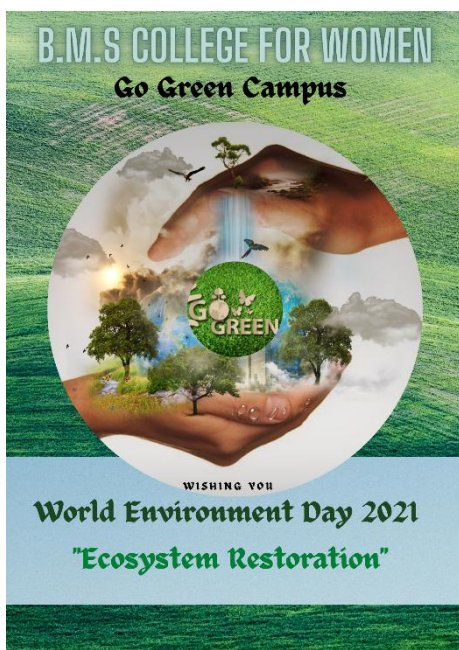
World Environment Day 5th June 2021
