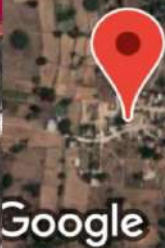

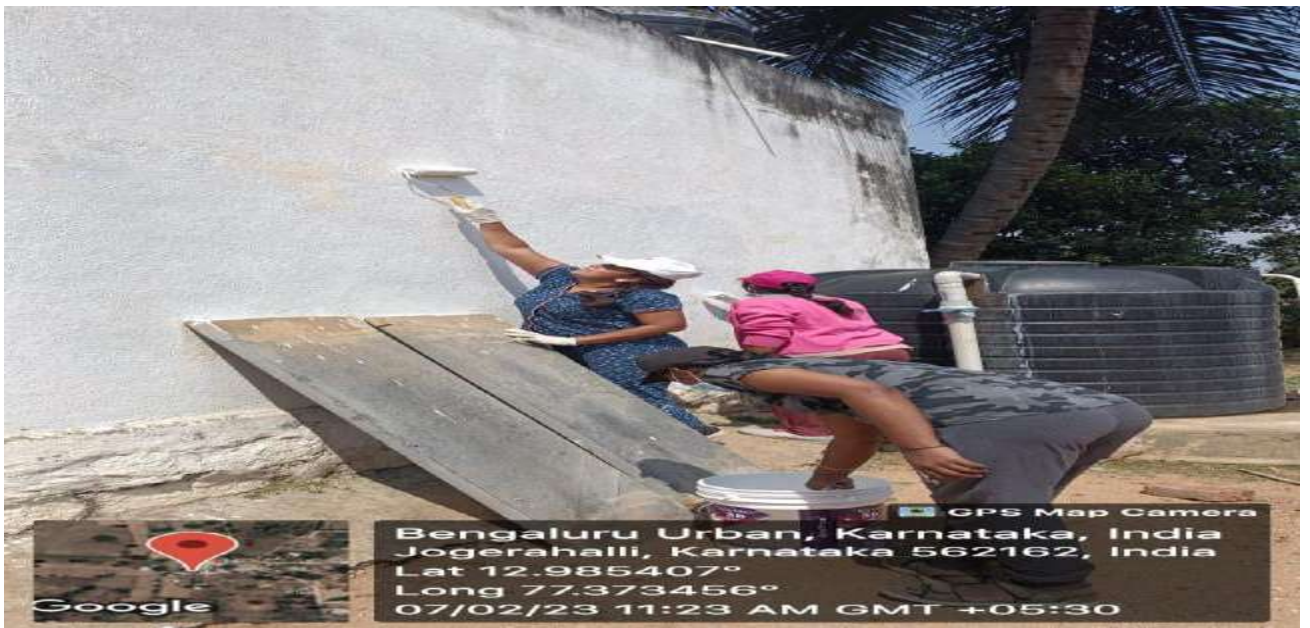
Later, all volunteers along with the members of UPKRITI NGO painted the Jogerhalli Government School and also the school premises was cleaned by the volunteers.

In the evening a street play regarding “Girls Education” was presented before the villagers and volunteers which created awareness about the Girls education to the villagers.

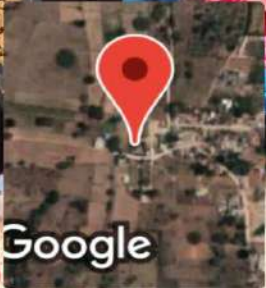
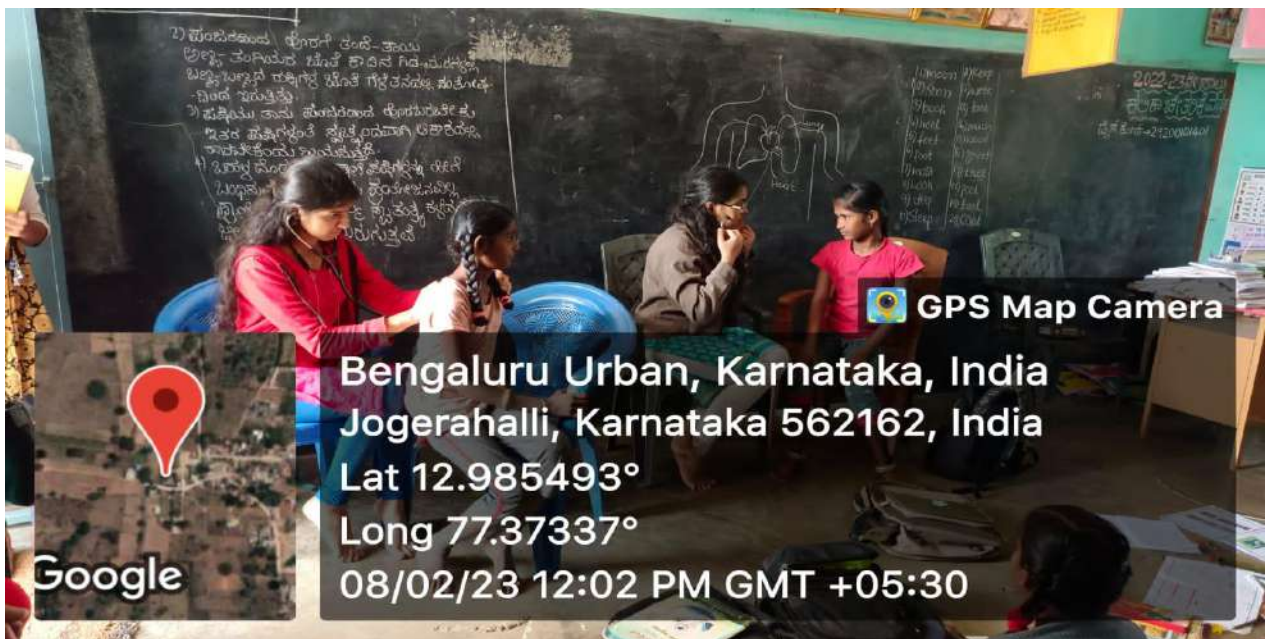
**Date: 08<sup>th</sup> February 2023**

**Date: 10<sup>th</sup> February 2023**

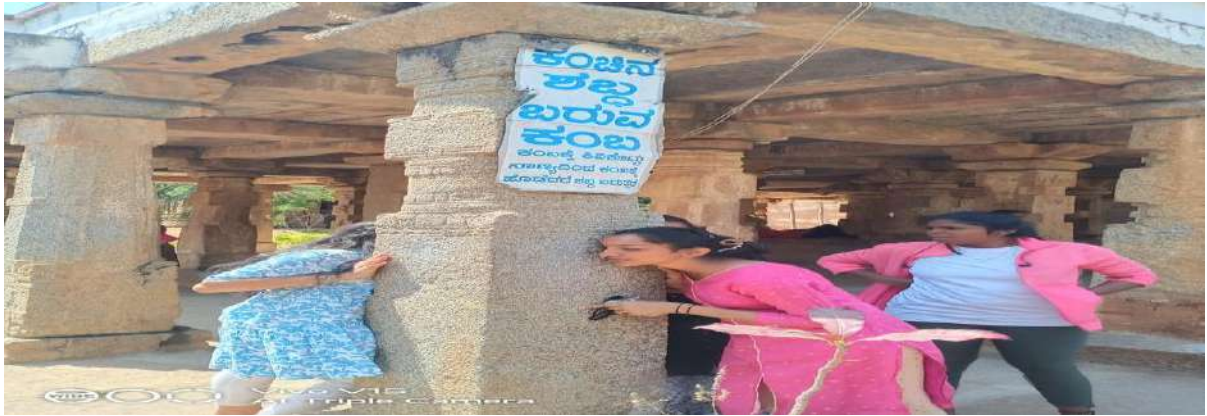
